

# Alaska Christian College Transfer of Credit Policies

General policies for the transfer of credit are as follows:

- Students may transfer a maximum of 16 credits into the Associate degrees.
- Credits earned at other institutions with a grade of “C” or better may be transferred to ACC and applied toward graduation, provided those credits meet the program requirements. Pass/no pass courses do not transfer. The institution needs to be recognized by an accrediting agency or acknowledged by ACC.
- The Vice President for Academic Affairs determines the applicability and credit awarded by reviewing coursework transferred from other institutions. Students may be asked to validate equivalent courses taken at non-accredited schools. After equivalency has been approved, the credits will be pending official approval until the student achieves a minimum GPA of 2.0. This must be done during the student’s first year at ACC or the transfer credits will be lost.
- Transfer students do not transfer in their GPA. Their cumulative GPA consists of classes taken only at ACC.
- Credits earned from ACC and transferred from other institutions will be counted toward the Credit Pace for Completion requirements.
